Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wear eye protection, chemical resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt and pants. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco.

FIRST AID

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

GENERAL INFORMATION

SAVVY is a highly concentrated blend of emulsifiers and methylated seed oil. The product is designed for use with a broad range of herbicides where a high surfactant oil concentrate adjuvant is recommended or allowed. High surfactant oil concentrates allow lower use rates than standard oil adjuvants. **SAVVY** increases contact activity and penetration of the spray, while also providing uniform coverage on leaf surfaces.

Always follow herbicide label recommendations. Care should be taken in treating sensitive crops during drought stress, high temperatures and high humidity.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To prepare for pesticide application, fill spray tank one-half full with water and begin agitation. Add pesticide or fertilizer as recommended and then add **SAVVY**, while continuing agitation. Fill tank and maintain agitation before and during application.

NOTE: The effect of any adjuvant on a chemicals performance is not predictable under all conditions of weather, plant vigor, application methods and even water types. The user should consult their local agricultural extension agent or do their own tests to determine the optimum level of **SAVVY** for special pesticide spray and crop.

APPLICATION OR USE RATES

Ground, Aerial, Low volume, CDA:

1% v/v (1 gallon per 100 gallons of water)	0.5-1% v/v (2-4 quarts per 100 gallons of water)
0.5% v/v (2 quarts per 100 gallons of water)	0.25-0.5% v/v (1-2 quarts per 100 gallons of water)
2 pints per acre	1-2 pints per acre
1.5 pint per acre	0.75-1.5 pint per acre
1 pint per acre	0.5-1 pint per acre

STORAGE, HANDLING AND DISPOSAL

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse. Then offer container for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill. If incineration is allowed, stay out of smoke. Material must be disposed of according to all local state and federal laws.

HANDLING AND STORAGE

For optimum storage stability, store at temperatures below 90°F (32°C). If **SAVVY** freezes, allow to thaw and agitate prior to use. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not store near oxidizing agents, extreme heat and other sources of ignition.
